How to do the enrollment - FAU Disciplines

ENROLLMENT HOW TO DO?

Enrollment in USP disciplines takes place after the start of the semester, and each USP Faculty has different procedures and deadlines.

Therefore, the student must pay attention to which USP teaching unit the discipline they want to enroll in belongs to.

ENROLLMENT HOW TO DO?

USP disciplines have codes, and by looking at these codes, it's possible to identify which unit a course belongs to.

Therefore, pay attention:

Only discipline that begin with AU or 16 are

FAU disciplines:

AUP 1587 | AUH 4875 | 1610205

If the discipline has any other letter in the code, it is not a FAU discipline, even if it is taught at FAU or is part of the FAU program.

ENROLLMENT HOW TO DO?

Some examples of disciplines **from other units** that are part of the architecture course program:

PEF0522 MAT0141 MAK0143

PHA0313 PTR0101

If the student wants to enroll in these disciplines, they must check which USP unit the discipline belongs to and follow the instructions for that unit to enroll!

Here we will talk specifically about enrollment in FAU courses:

Enrollment in FAU courses takes place **one or two** weeks after the start of the semester.

This period is for students to "test" the classes, talk to the professor, and see the discipline syllabus.



To help create their schedule, students can use <u>MATRUSP</u>, a virtual platform created by USP students.


To find classrooms for each discipline, students can use the classroom reservation link:

Reserva de Salas FAU



To correctly find the classroom for your subject, make sure you are searching both in the FAU building in **Butantã** and in the one on Rua **Maranhão**:

To enroll, it is important to pay attention to FAU's rules:

- Only the disciplines offered in the <u>Jupiterweb list</u> are available for enrollment at FAU.
- "Optional" subjects (it's finalized in odd numbers):
 there is a limit of two disciplines per student.
- "Mandatory" subjects (it's finalized in pair numbers):
 do not exceed the limit of 40 credits.

Note: the classification "mandatory" and "optional" does not have the literal meaning for exchange students.

To confirm that there are no schedule conflicts between the disciplines chosen for the semester (overlap), create your schedule through MATRUSP:

MATRUSP Grade Horária



After you have:

- attended a class, talked to the professor, seen the discipline syllabus
- checked whether your choices correspond to FAU rules
- created the timetable to check for any conflicts between the courses

It's time to enroll

Enrollment is done by the student (in person), at the FAU Serviço de Graduação (mezzanine floor);

The student must complete the Enrollment Form with the disciplines they wish to take.

Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis, so there may not be a place available in some discipline.

We suggest that you apply for enrollment in one or two additional disciplines to guarantee your semester schedule.

There is a specific period to exclude any discipline that the student does not want to follow. Stay tuned for deadlines!

After 2 weeks of enrollment, if your name does not appear on the discipline attendance list, immediately contact the Serviço de Graduação to check your enrollment.
